PROJECT EYE OPENER

Ramana Vision Program

The Program:

An eye clinic was held on the 27th of November, 2022 targeting primarily the local elderly. Dr Chandrakumar, a renown eye surgeon from STS Hospital, Jaffna and his team of about 10 staff conducted the clinic at Ramanalayam, which was attended by a staggering 84 people in the span of 4 hours. Around 20 elders were provided with reading glass free of charge by STS Hospital. During the clinic, around 20 elders from the local villages were diagnosed with severe eye conditions or cataract. According to Dr Chandrakumar, unless quick action is taken to rectify their condition, they may lose their sight completely within a few months. He suggests, with approximately Rs 22,000, a lens can be obtained and surgery done, on at least one eye and restore vision partially.

The surgery will be conducted on private-public partnership by the doctors at STS Hospital.
